To make this site work properly, we sometimes place small data files called cookies on your device. Most big websites do this too.

WHAT ARE COOKIES?

A cookie is a small text file that a website saves on your computer or mobile device when you visit the site. It enables the website to remember your actions and preferences (such as login, language, and font size and other display preferences) over a period, so you do not have to keep re-entering them whenever you come back to the site or browse from one page to another.

HOW DO WE USE COOKIES?

TECHNICAL COOKIES

Technical cookies are cookies installed by the website that the user is visiting. It is necessary for navigation on the site, allow you to use the core functionality and secure the connection, maintain the session identifiers and store information relating to authentication.

Without these cookies, some or all of the site's features may not be usable.

THIRD PARTY COOKIES

We describe below the third-party cookies that may be used by the site, the links through which the user can receive more information and how to request their deactivation.

- **GOOGLE FONTS**

- **PIWIK ANALYTICS**

Piwik uses cookies to identify and track visitors and their use of the website. All collected data is anonymous and in aggregate form. The full privacy policy can be viewed at <http://piwik.org/privacy>

The Piwik service complies with the "Do Not Track" settings, a technology that allows users to exclude themselves from tracking the sites they visit. If the user is using a browser compatible with this technology, you should set preferences to "I do not want to be traced" (Do Not Track).
