Quick Facts

- 60 National Authorities
- Disciplines: Formula 1, Formula 2, Class 1, Xcat, Aquabike, Hydro GP, Pleasure Navigation
- Approximately 225 drivers with Super License issued by UIM office
- Approximately 1250 drivers with International License issued by National Authorities
- 6 Staff members in the HQ in Monaco
- 1 part-time Anti-Doping Administrator since mid 2012
- Fully WADA compliant since 2009



UIM Anti-Doping Structure

- Working Group : 7 members
- Independent Anti-Doping Review Panel: 3 members
- Doping Hearing Panel: 5 members
- TUE Committee: 3 members



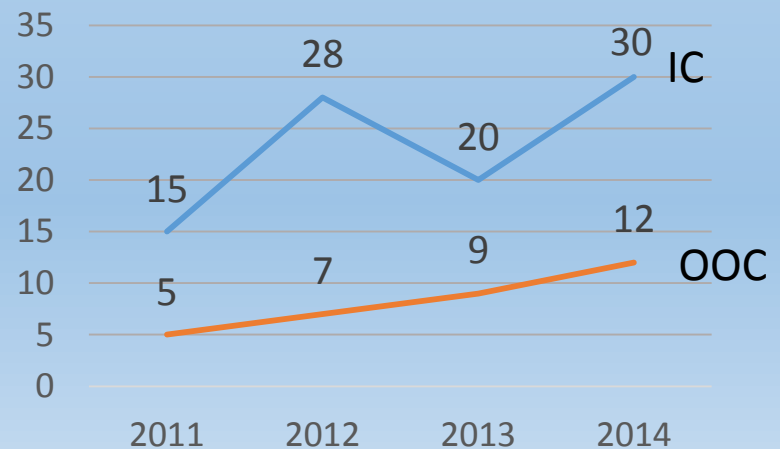
Testing History

Registered Testing Pool (RTP)

- 2011 10 drivers (from 5 disciplines)
- 2012 26 drivers (from 1 discipline)
- 2013 20 drivers (from 5 disciplines)
- 2014 12 drivers (from 5 disciplines)

Testing Statistics

- 2011 15 IC / 5 OOC = 20 tests
 - (OOO tests are pre-comp)
- 2012 28 IC / 7 OOC = 35 tests
 - (some OOC tests are pre-comp)
- 2013 20 IC / 9 OOC = 29 tests
 - (+ 6 UAs)
- 2014 30 IC / 12 OOC = 42 tests



Cost Efficiency

- Use of a service provider (IDTM)
- Combine with test with other Federations
- UIM Anti-doping person can focus on:
whereabouts quality, intelligence, driver communication and education
- Standardized doping control procedures & forms
- If a driver is in a remote/difficult location
> pre-competition testing
- Use of DCA not needed when DCO is of same gender



Whereabouts

- IC testing is focused on drivers outside the RTP > education and prevention
 - Every driver on the RTP is tested at least once per year
 - Strict follow up on whereabouts submission & quality
 - Whereabouts collected for testing purposes but also for deterrence
- 5 confirmed Missed Tests in 2013
 - 5 confirmed Filing Failures in 2013



Education

- Direct communication with the driver (email/phone)
- National Authority and agent copied on communication
- Distribution of 2014 List walled cards and booklets at competitions
- UIM website has an ANTI-DOPING section:
 - ADAMS information and instructions
 - TUE information
 - WADA Doping Control process
 - WADA Anti-Doping facts & high lights
 - UIM Anti-Doping rules
 - Prohibited list
 - Current RTP



Anti-Doping Violations 2011-2013

(UIM authorized tests)

- 2011 1 positive sample (stimulant)
- 2012 2 positive samples (steroids & cannabis)
- 2013 0 positive samples
- Sanctioned athletes are, as a standard procedure, added to the RTP before the end of their ineligibility period and kept on the list throughout the year



IOC Contribution to the UIM Anti-Doping Program

- Annual IOC contribution is 25,000 USD (approx. 18,000 Euro)
- Covers about half of the overall annual UIM costs



Conclusion

- Possible to have an effective anti-doping program with limited recourses
- Have right people in right places
- Consult WADA
- Cooperate with other anti-doping organizations
- Consider using a service provider
- Full support from the President/General Secretary
